

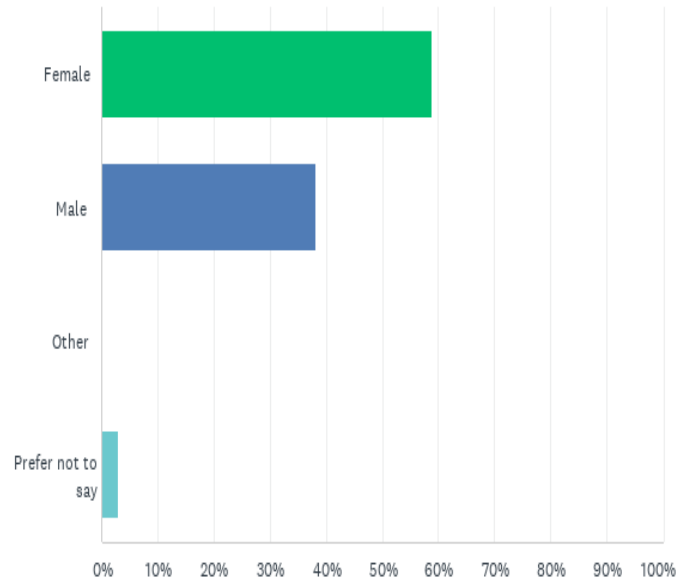

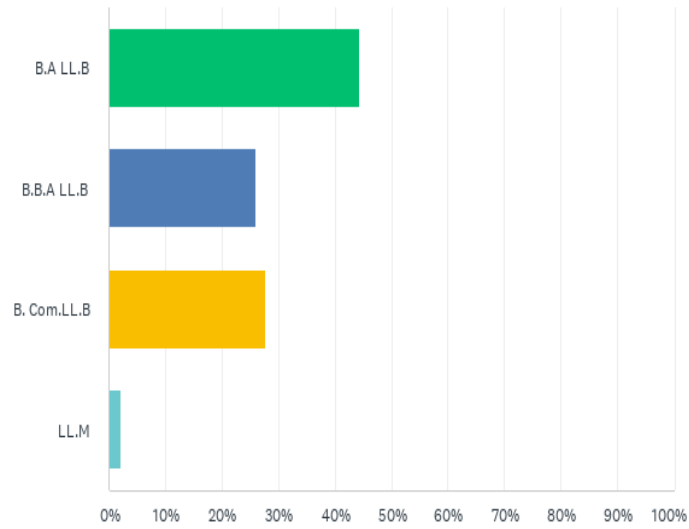

Q1 Gender



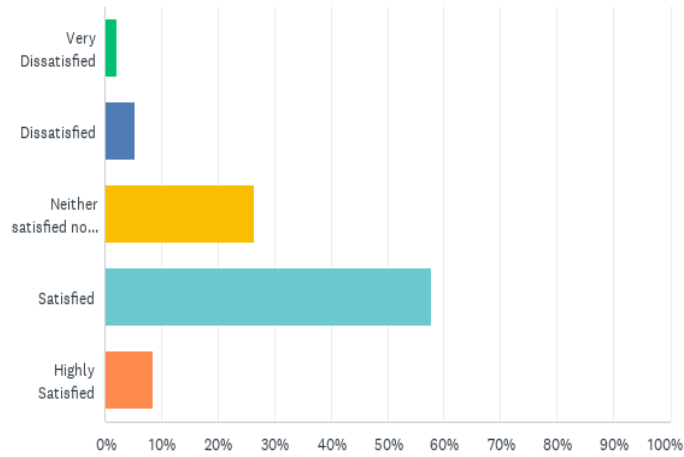

Q2 What Degree Programme are you currently pursuing?



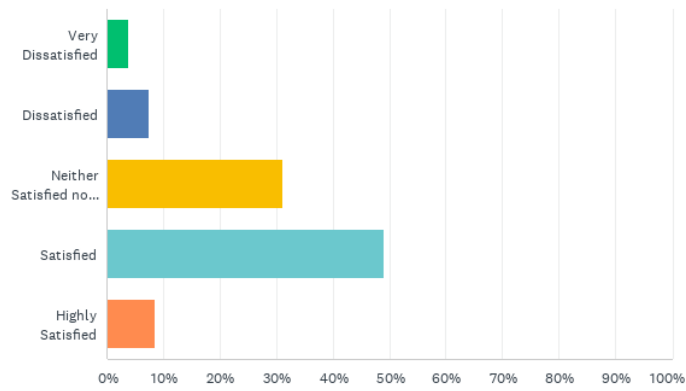

Q3 How will you rate your satisfaction with the level of preparedness of the teachers for the classes?



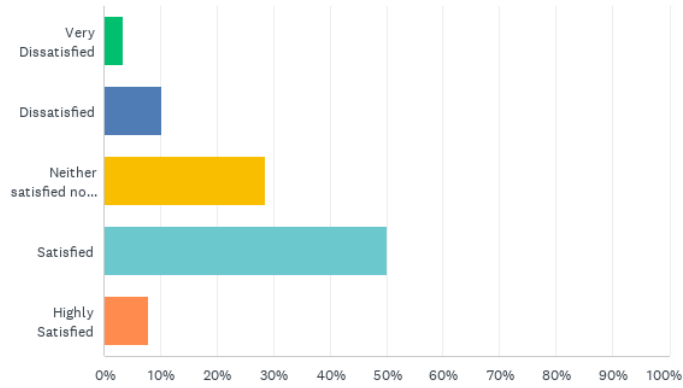

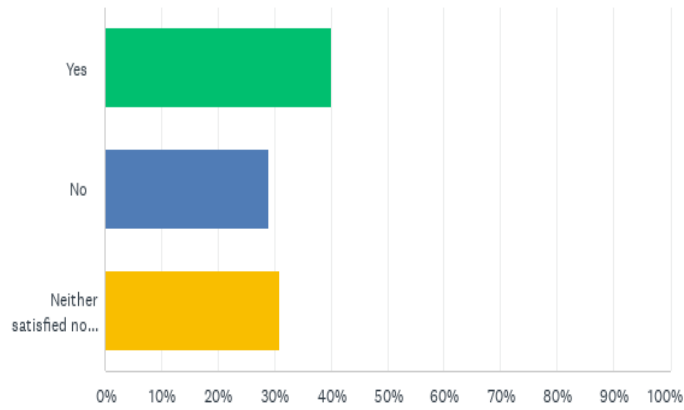

Q5 How will you rate your level of satisfaction with the teachers' illustration of concepts using examples and application?



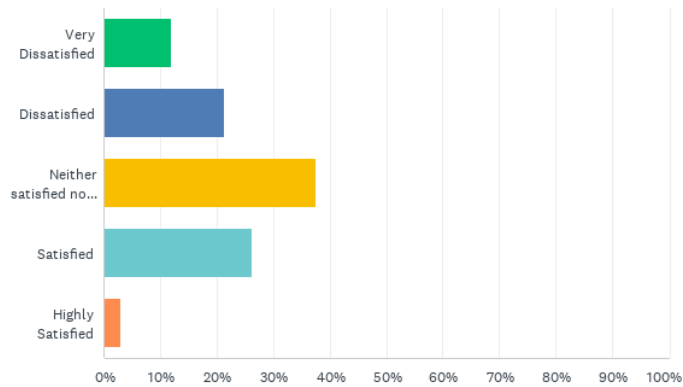

Q6 Are you satisfied with the syllabus covered in the class?



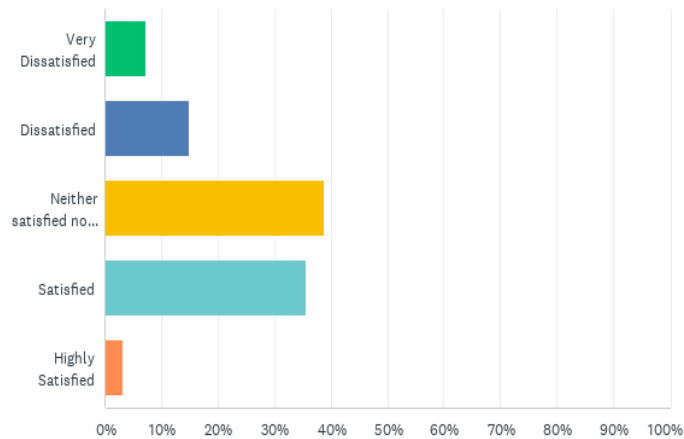

Q7 How would you rate your level of satisfaction with the ability of the teachers to identify your weaknesses and help you in overcoming them?



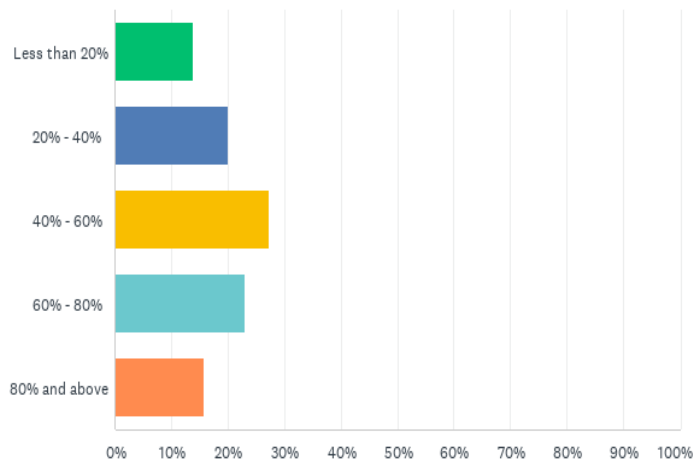

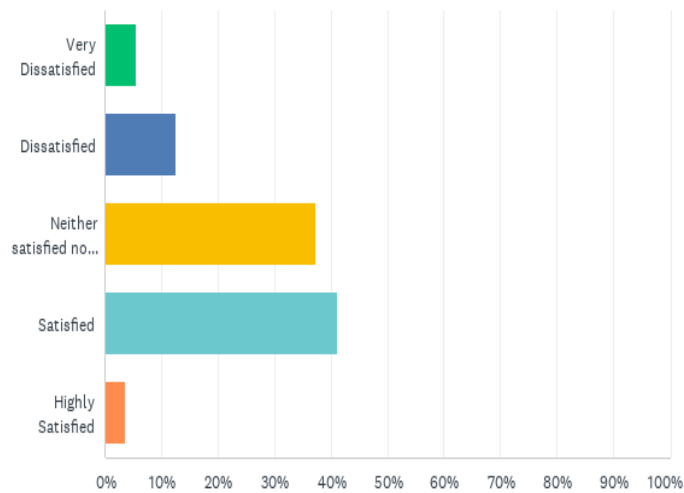

Q9 What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projectors and other multimedia in the teaching-learning process?



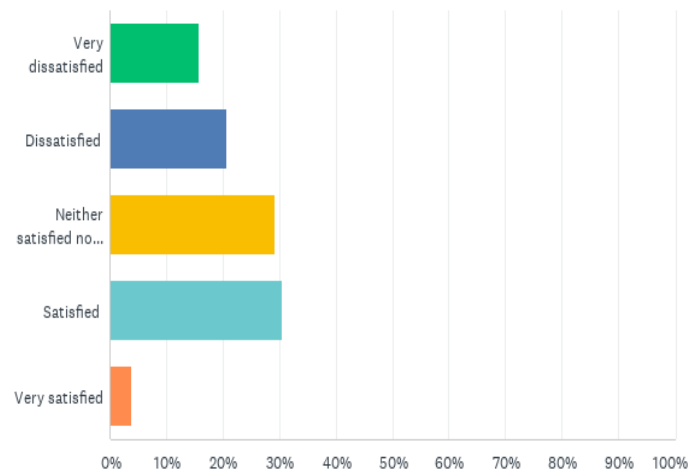

Q10 How would you rate your level of satisfaction with the information provided to you with respect to the expected course competencies and outcomes?



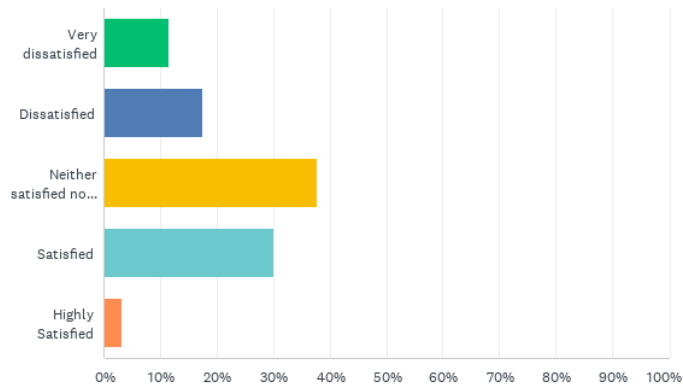

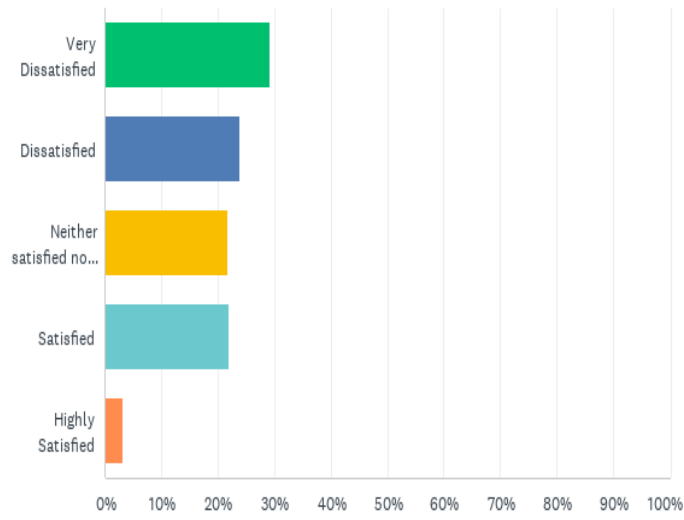

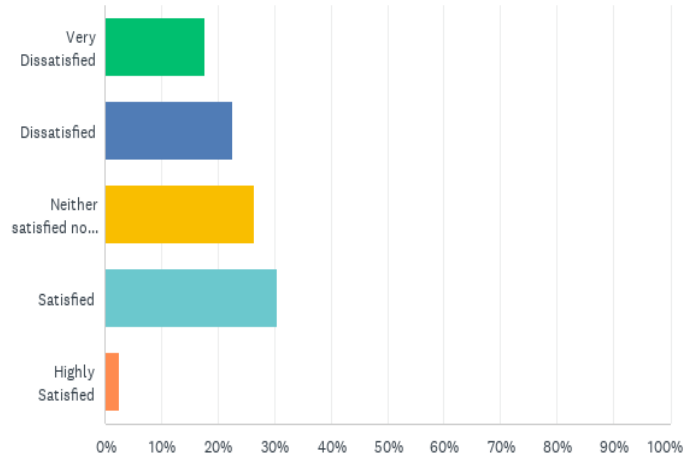

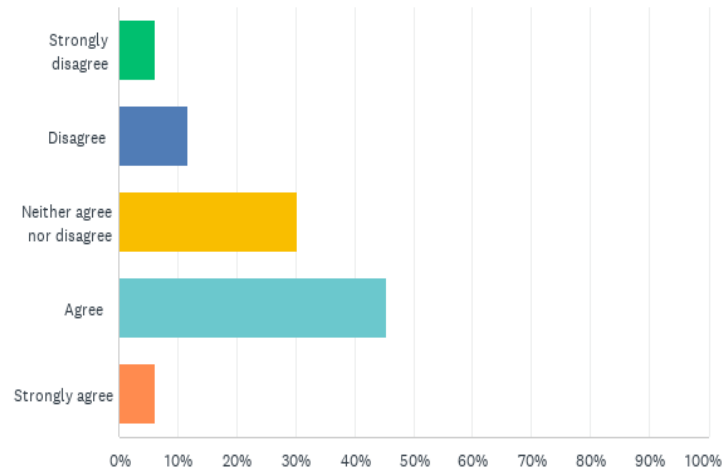

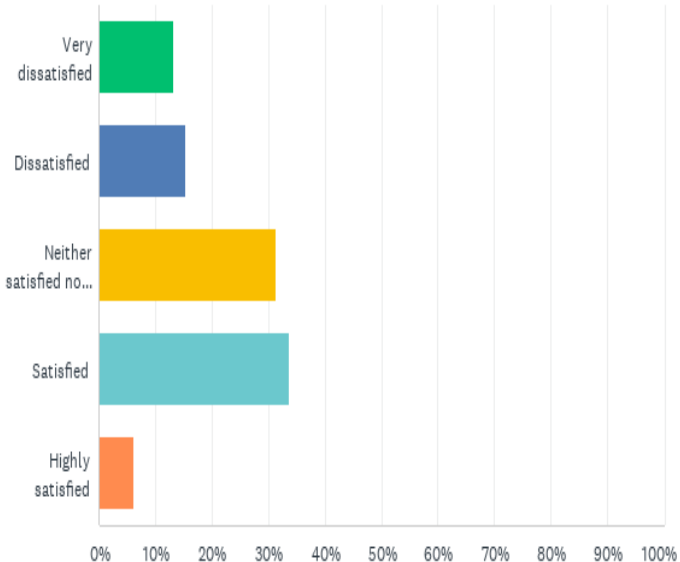

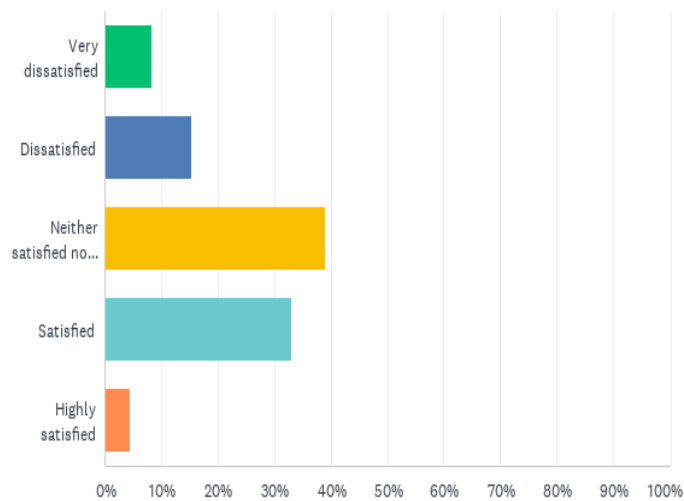

Q16 How will you rate your level of satisfaction with the necessary follow-ups by the mentors?



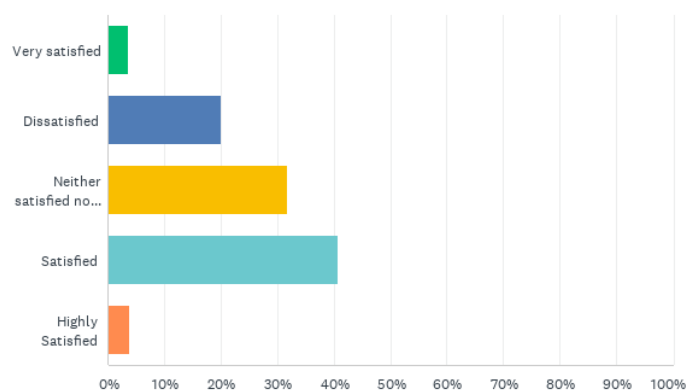

Q17 How will you rate your level of satisfaction with the internal feedback mechanism at your institution?



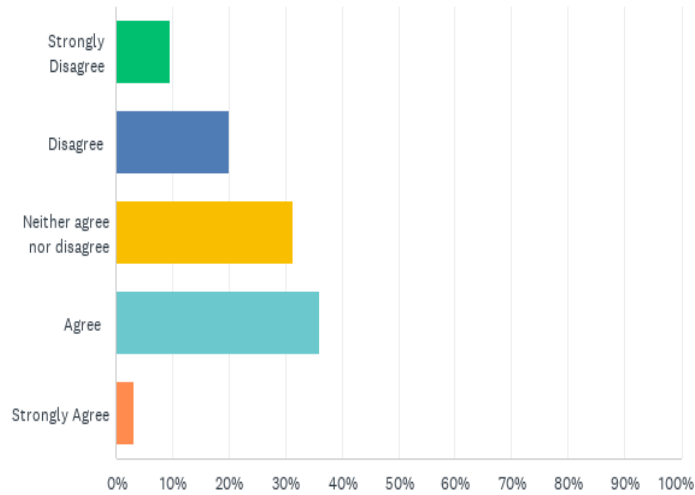

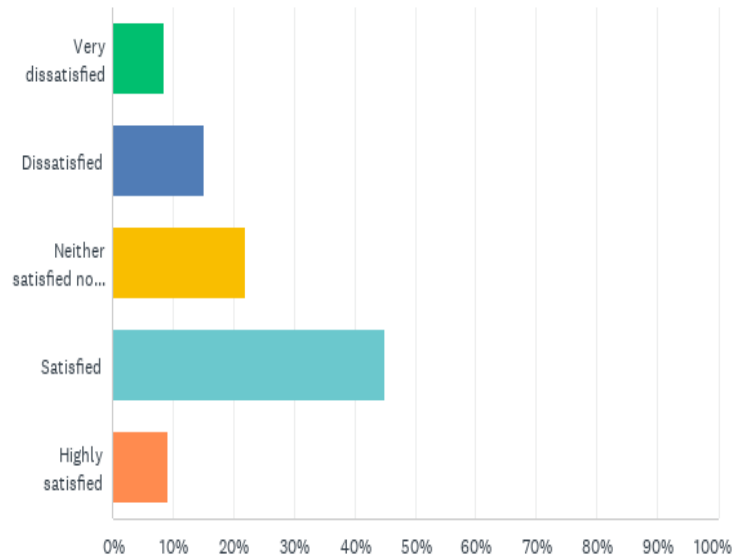

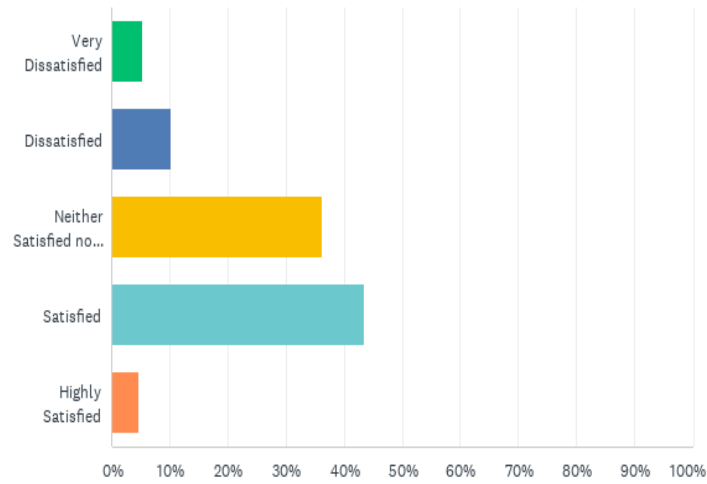
