ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE (POLICY)

## Policy and Regulation

Ragging is a criminal offence. Ramaiah college of Law has constituted Anti Ragging Cell as per the UGC guidelines. The committee is dedicated with its objective to root out ragging in all its form, from the campus by preventing its reoccurrence and punishing the wrong-doers, in compliance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009 dated 17 June 2009, as Gazetted on 4 July 2009 and the amendments thereto from time to time. The Department's Regulation known as RCL'S regulation, for Prevention and Control of Ragging(UGC,2009) as approved by the Director of Academic affairs and the Principal of RCL is intended for prevention, elimination and control of the menace of Ragging in all forms on the students of the Institution whether within or outside its Campuses and to punish those who indulge in ragging.

## Anti- Ragging Committee

The Anti-Ragging Cell shall be headed by the Director of Academic Affairs and the Principal. The body also has representatives of faculty members, representatives of Student's Union with a diverse mix of membership in terms of levels as well as gender.

The Committee meets at least once in every semester to discuss on the progress of making the college premise a ragging free zone by close surveillance and recommending preventing measures. The cell also conducts itself well by monitoring any activities which can be called as Ragging and examining the offence if any, reported.

### Anti-Ragging Squad

As per the UGC guidelines, RCL has a smaller body known as the Anti-Ragging Squad. The Squad works as a Watchdog by doing its duty of being vigilant, doing patrolling and by being constant active towards effective functioning of the team. Squad members for inspections target places like hostels, canteen and other possible areas of detecting ragging related crimes. It shall also be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Squad to conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.

The committee is all inclusive consisting of Faculty members including one from the Disciplinary Committee along with fresher students senior students.

## PUNISHMENT

Students who indulge in the acts of ragging shall attract the punishments as applicable, which include any one or combination thereof :

1. Expulsion from the College/hostel
2. Suspension from the classes
3. Fine with a public apology
4. Withholding of scholarship or other benefits extended to those involved in ragging
5. Debarring from representation in cultural or sports events, or any other representation in events for which the student(s) may have been selected
6. No placement assistance to students found guilty of ragging.

The College will summarily punish or reprimand the guilty student, either by itself or by following procedures, administrative or otherwise, by constituting a special Enquiry Committee and put forth its findings or recommendations before the competent authority to take a decision.
